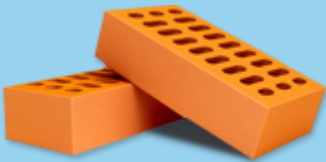

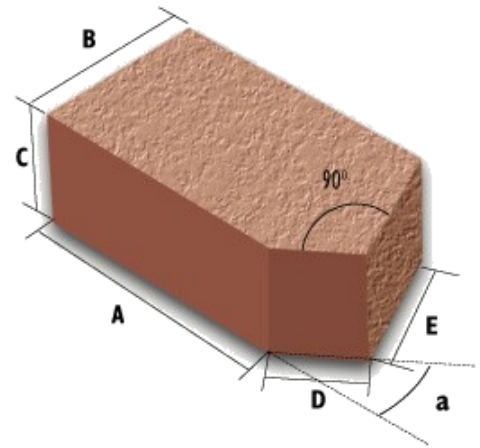

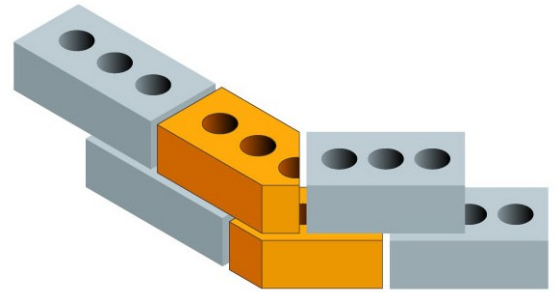

AN.1 Squint

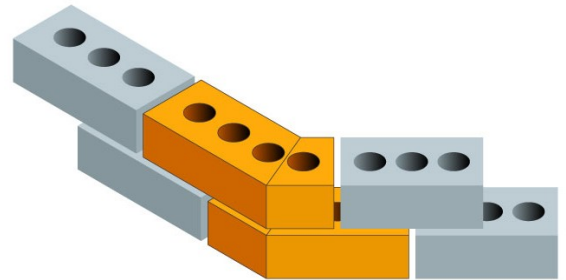
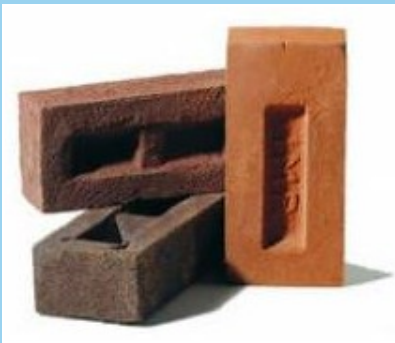
Squint bricks are typically used to create angled corners. Available in different angles and left or right handed if the brick has a textured surface.



AN.2 External Angle

Externally Angled bricks are typically used to create angled corners with standard brick lengths facing externally.

Available in different angles and left or right handed if the brick has a textured surface.



PL.3 Plinth Stretcher

Plinth Stretchers as the name suggests are for creating plinths or splaying and thickening a wall at the base of a building.

The chamfered face is at a 45° angle as standard along the length of the brick.
